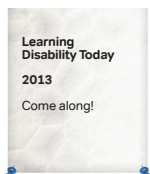

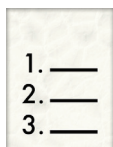
## The A-Z of learning disabilities

There will be lots of ideas and information for families/family carers and people supporting people with learning disabilities.



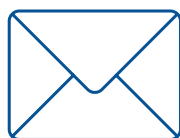
